Welcome to the 2016 Season.

The Club is involved at all levels of the Munster Cricket Leagues and Cups including the All Ireland National Cup.

It is very important that you read this letter carefully and note the following:-

Annual subscriptions and match fees

At our recent AGM a Motion was passed that every player who wishes to play for County Kerry Cricket Club at any level must have the annual subscription paid in full before they can participate in any game. If a player hasn't paid his annual subscription, he will not be selected. This rule will be rigidly enforced. It should be noted a player will not be covered by the Club's personal accident insurance if his subscription is not paid.

All members are expected to help with the keep up and maintenance of the grounds.

Please note there is personal injury insurance cover in place.

Compulsory matters

Subscription fees, match fees and the wearing of helmets during the net practice are all compulsory matters.

Home games

Every member should ensure that he has food for himself and his opposing player at the innings break. As you are aware team travel long just to play cricket in Munster and it is only reasonable to ensure that our guest are looked after.

General standards

Please note whites are compulsory for all league and cup games. There is also the introduction of coloured clothing in Senior League games. Every effort should be made by every Kerry Cricket player throughout the Season to be pleasant, courteous, respectful and welcoming to all visiting sites. All members and players are expected to help with the running of the game, putting out the boundary ropes, boundary flags, help with the equipment and scoring.

We have a beautiful new ground and we want to keep it tidy and litter free. Each member should be in attendance at the Club approx. one hour before the commencing of the game.

Match fees

Every player must pay €10 per game and for players taking park in a second game over weekend the fee will be €15. For students and unemployed the match fee is €5/€10 (for both games). Please ensure you have your match fee on the day. As you can appreciate it is extremely frustrating for the Captain/Club officers to go chasing after players for their match fee. The Club relies very heavily on match fees to cover the costs of balls and equipment which are extremely expensive.

Practise nights

While traditionally practise nights are on Tuesday and Thursday, now that we have our own ground practise can take part any day any night 7 days a week.

20/20 League

We are revamping the 20/20 League and full details will be furnished.

Communication

Every player should know by Thursday evening whether or not they are available to play at the weekend. It is essential the players communicate with their team Captain or their club Officer of their availability. Last season there was a quite a number of late cry offs which caused great difficulty resulting in teams travelling with less than 11 players.
